


- (1) The special act establishing the Agency was passed May 15th, 1972, by Chapter 514 of the Laws of 1972 which became effective May 15th, 1972.
- (2) The name of the Agency is:

The above members of said Agency are members of the Malone Town Board and their terms of office are to coincide with their terms of

- (4) The facts establishing the need for such Agency in the municipality are as follows:
- (a) That the County of Franklin, and more particularly the Town of Malone, has had during the past year, an unemployment rate of approximately 20%.
  - (b) That there is a dire need for industrial development in said town.
  - (c) That the existing agencies and organizations have been unsuccessful in attracting business and industry to said town.
  - (d) That the Town Board has, in the past, endeavored to attract industry and business to said town by various means, including tax incentives for establishing new industry, or expanding existing ones.
  - (e) That the establishment of an industrial development agency in said town with the authority to issue industrial revenue bonds will greatly promote the industrial development of the area and will result in increased job opportunities for the residents of said town.
