WHEREAS, on or about September 3, 2021, Yellow 17, LLC filed an application for a Zoning Permit for the “Malone Solar Project” to be located at 176 Bare Hill Road in the Town of Malone (the “Proposed Action”), and

WHEREAS, as part of its application for a Zoning Permit, the Applicant submitted a Full Environmental Assessment Form dated August 26, 2021, and

WHEREAS, on or about February 11, 2022, Yellow 17, LLC filed a response to a deficiency letter for the Proposed Action with supplemental materials in support of its application, and

WHEREAS, on or about October 12, 2022, Yellow 17, LLC filed supplemental materials in support of its application, and

TOWN OF MALONE
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WHEREAS, the Town Board adopted a Resolution on May 11, 2022, which classified the project as a Type I Action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), and

WHEREAS, the Town Board assumed lead agency status pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.6(b)(1), and

WHEREAS, the Town Board conducted public hearings on the proposed project on June 22, 2022, and July 13, 2022, and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2022, the Town Board made a Positive Declaration of Environmental Significance, requiring preparation of a DEIS, and

WHEREAS, on or about June 26, 2023, the Applicant filed a draft Environmental Impact Statement Scoping Document for the Malone Solar Project and held a public hearing on the scoping document on September 13, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the Final Scoping Document was accepted by the Town Board on September 27, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the Applicant submitted a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (“DEIS”) in November 2023 and submitted a revised DEIS on or about February 6, 2024. The DEIS was deemed adequate for public review on March 6, 2024 and a public hearing was held on March 27, 2024 with the public comment period ending April 12, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Applicant submitted updated studies since the DEIS, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to SEQRA, the Town Board accepted and filed the FEIS on November 20, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the Town has now completed its review of the potential impacts of the project; considered relevant environmental impacts, facts and conclusions disclosed in the FEIS, and weighed and balanced relevant environmental impacts; and taken a hard look at the potential significant adverse impacts together with the proposed mitigating measures and based on said review has prepared a Findings Statement which is annexed hereto and incorporated in its entirety into this resolution, and

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board hereby adopts the annexed Findings Statement on the Project pursuant to the provisions of SEQRA.

AND THEREFORE, the Town Board, pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.11(d), certifies that the requirements of SEQRA have been met, and that consistent with social, economic and other essential considerations from among the reasonable alternatives available, the Project is one that avoids or minimizes adverse environmental impacts to the maximum extent practicable, and that adverse environmental impacts will be avoided or minimized to the maximum extent practicable by incorporating as conditions to the decision those mitigative measures that were identified as practicable.

AND THEREFORE, the Findings Statement shall be filed, distributed and maintained, as necessary, pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.11 and 617.12.

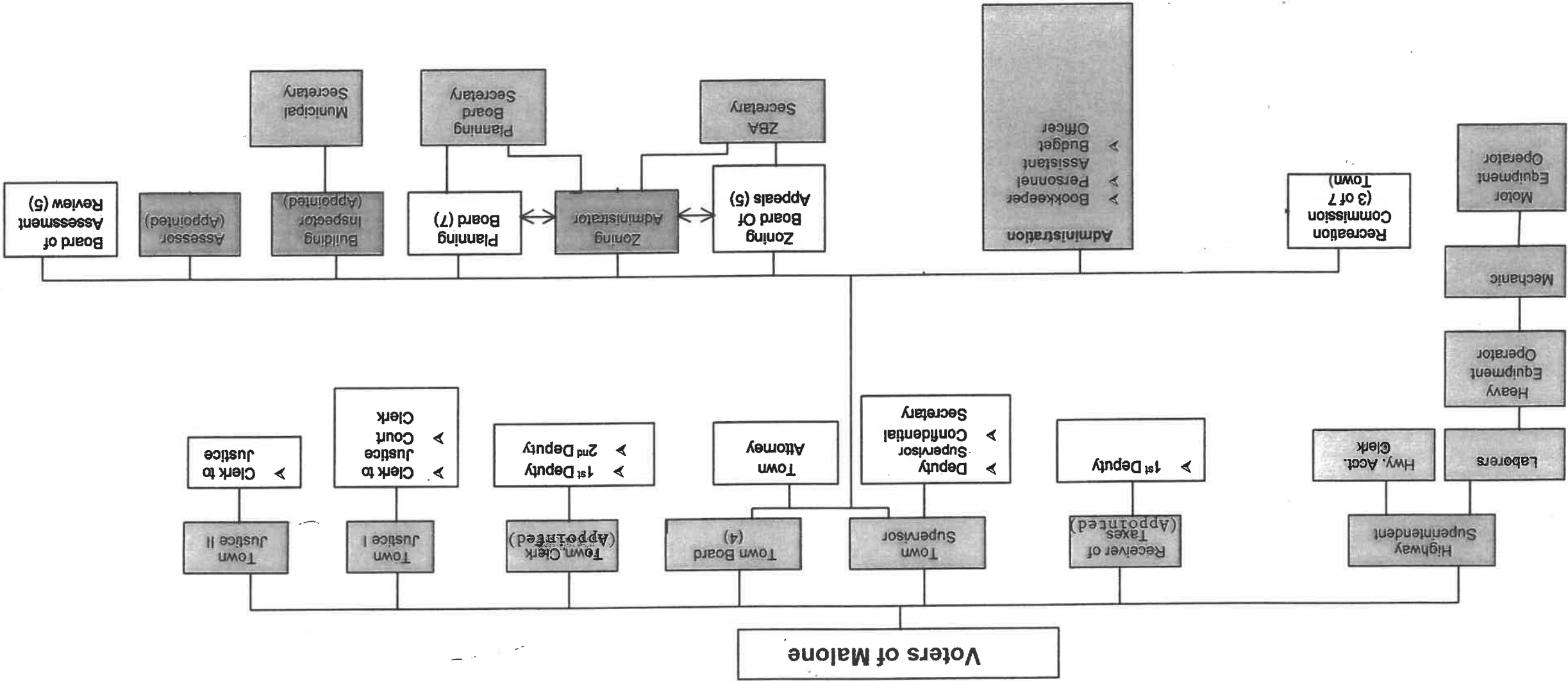

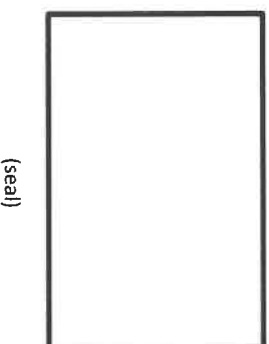

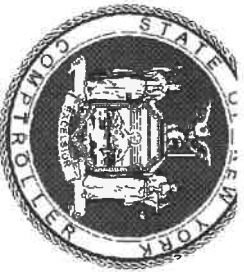

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, 2025, by and between the **TOWN OF MALONE**, a Municipal Corporation, having its office in the Town of Malone, County of Franklin and State of New York, hereinafter referred to as "**Town**") and the **MALONE ADULT CENTER** of the Village of Malone, County of Franklin and State of New York, (hereinafter referred to as "**Center**").

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Center provides vital and life sustaining services to the senior population of the Town and without the Center's services, many of the Towns' impoverished and isolated seniors would face malnourishment and starvation; and

WHEREAS the Town, which has historically supported the Center, wishes to continue to ensure that the Center remains economically viable.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Center, which has been funded by the Town in the past, is administered by its Board of Directors.
2. The Malone Center provides services and programs to the Senior Citizens of the Town. These services include but are not limited to: Congregate meals, Home delivered meals to homebound seniors, Case management and assistance, Transportation, and Escort Service, HEAP Program Counseling. We offer numerous recreational activities and health promotions such as flu and Pneumonia clinics, blood pressure and glucose screening. The center is open from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday year round.
3. The Town agrees to pay the Malone Center the sum of **TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00) dollars** to assist in providing the above-mentioned services to the seniors of our community.
4. The Center agrees to provide said Town with a detailed budget report or other financial statement, specifying how funds were spent each fiscal year, for Town Board review.
5. The Center agrees to act as a shelter for Town and Village of Malone residents in the event of an emergency.
6. It is hereby further mutually agreed and understood by and between the aforementioned parties that no bills are to be contracted directly or indirectly in the name of the Town by the Center.

7. It is hereby mutually agreed and understood by and between said parties that the Center will hold harmless, defend, and indemnify the Town, its officers and employees and servants from any debts, claims, and causes of action, caused by the negligence or improper conduct on the part of the said Center or any of its members.

8. It is hereby further mutually agreed and understood by and between said parties that the Supervisor of the Town, pursuant to authorization conferred by a Resolution of the Town Board of the Town, is hereby authorized to execute and enter into this Contract with said Center for a period of one year, to wit: Calendar year 2025.
